Step 1. Choose an Image

A good image will do the following:

1. Connect students to a personal experience
2. Relate to the curriculum
3. Leave students with questions

Step 2. Craft investigative questions

Good investigative questions do the following:

1. Scaffold the learning process
2. Use spiraling questions that draw students into thinking about the topic

Step 3. Determine the type of product or performance that students will use to answer the question.

- Consider the most appropriate way of answering the investigative questions. It could be by speaking, writing, drawing, moving, building, etc...
- Also consider if you want students to respond individually, in pairs, in groups, or as a whole class.

Step 4. Choose an understanding goal
