## Create Your Own Images Draw You In Activity

#### Step 1. Choose an Image

A good image will do the following:

- 1. Connect students to a personal experience
- 2. Relate to the curriculum
- 3. Leave students with questions

#### Step 2. Craft investigative questions

Good investigative questions do the following:

- 1. Scaffold the learning process
- 2. Use spiraling questions that draw students into thinking about the topic

# Step 3. Determine the type of product or performance that students will use to answer the question.

- Consider the most appropriate way of answering the investigative questions. It could be by speaking, writing, drawing, moving, building, etc...
- Also consider if you want students to respond individually, in pairs, in groups, or as a whole class.

### Step 4. Choose an understanding goal
